**JUDGES COMMENTS:**

When asked to judge the miniature goats at the Boonah show I happily accepted although I was a little apprehensive as while I have judged dairy goats for several years I had never previously judged miniature goats so was a little out of my comfort zone.

Upon my arrival at the showgrounds I was greeted with a group of very polite and friendly miniature goat breeders.

They all appeared to know one another and everyone went out of their way to help and encourage one another throughout the day which was excellent to see.

The first few classes were somewhat daunting as they included the various ear classes and the head class – now this was something I had not encountered previously – we don't have specific classes for heads and ears within the dairy goats. I have to admit these classes were a bit difficult but once I got my head around what I was looking for, it was not as daunting as first thought. But I have to say that I was relieved once they were out of the way.

The age classes etc were much more like what I was used to and I felt much more within my comfort zone. The goats presented on the day were all of a very high standard and I was particularly impressed with the overall confirmation of the majority of the goats. All of them had good top lines with most having lovely flat broad rumps and nice wide back ends with good straight legs. Both the bucks and the does presented on the day were all excellent examples of miniature goats and the overall best in show doe was a lovely doe in all respects.

I commend the owners, breeders and exhibitors on the quality of the goats that were shown on the day. I also commend the sportsmanship by each of the exhibitors it was pleasing to see people who have a likeminded interest all coming together for the benefit of exhibiting and promoting their miniature goats.

Lastly I would like to thank Rosalie for arranging for me to come up and judge and also her husband Alan who was my steward for the day and kept the day on track.

All in all an excellent day and I hope everyone learnt something, I know I did.
